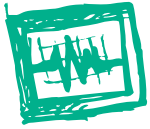
Supporting Self-Reliance

Award Categories



Technology & Innovation

New technologies and techniques that encourage healthy and productive aging, that improve the way that older persons receive care, or that provide greater efficiency, safety, and/or convenience for older persons and caregivers



Community-Based Initiatives

Community-based approaches—including inter-generational approaches—to keeping older adults healthy, active, engaged, and/or safe



Supporting Self-Reliance

New ways to help older adults maintain, improve, or restore physical and mental functions, that assist them and their caregivers as those functions deteriorate, or that build resilience

Eligibility

Eligible innovations include policies, programs, services, and products implemented by community organizations, nonprofit organizations, research institutions, local governments, private businesses, public-private partnerships, and social businesses based in an ASEAN member country or in China, Japan, or South Korea.

One Grand Prize will be selected in each category, and additional finalists will be selected as Honorable Mention awardees. All Grand Prize and Honorable Mention recipients will be showcased on the AHWIN website.

Grand Prize winners will be honored at the 2020 AHWIN Forum and invited to present their work to top leaders from around the region. The Grand Prize award includes travel and accommodations for one representative to attend the Forum.
