Tamaki Tsukada was appointed Deputy Assistant Minister for International Cooperation and Global Issues in July 2017 after serving as Spokesperson and Head of Communications at the Embassy of Japan in Washington D.C. (2014-2017) and Minister for Economic Affairs at the Embassy of Japan in New Delhi (2011-2014).

He joined the Japanese Ministry of Foreign Affairs in 1987. Worked in the areas of development cooperation (loan aid; policy planning; ODA budget), energy & food security, and trade negotiations among others. Seconded to the Cabinet Secretariat in 2006-2008 as senior coordinator for overseas development cooperation and global health.

Served in the Japanese Embassy in London (Bilateral economic & Commercial) 1990-1992; Moscow (Political & Foreign policy) 1999-2001; and the Permanent Mission to the UN in Geneva (Human Rights & Humanitarian; Specialized Agencies) 2001-2004.

He holds a BA in Law from Tokyo University (1987) and a BA/MA in History from Oxford University (1990).
